A. MASTERS IN PUBLIC HEALTH (MPH) PROGRAMS

Join our Masters in Public Health (Morning/Evening) program to become leading public health professionals capable of addressing public health problems pertinent to global, regional, national and local population through multidisciplinary approaches that apply the latest scientific knowledge.

Eligibility Criteria for MPH Program (Morning & Evening Shift)

Sixteen years (16 years) of Education in the following fields;

MBBS, MD, BDS or equivalent qualification (Recognized by PMDC), BSc Nursing (Recognized by PNC), BSc Paramedics, BSc Vision Sciences, BSc Human Nutrition, BSc Physiotherapy, Pharmacy (Pharm-B, Pharm-D).

B. MASTERS IN PUBLIC HEALTH (MATERNAL & CHILD HEALTH) MPH (MNCH) (MORNING PROGRAM)

Enroll in two years MPH MNCH degree program in Khyber Medical University to develop the knowledge and skills to recognize, examine and evaluate the social, economic, biological and behavioral determinants impacting health of mothers and children pertinent to global, national, regional and local population.

Eligibility Criteria

Sixteen years (16 years) of education in the following fields;

MBBS, MD or equivalent qualification (Recognized by PMDC), BSc Nursing (Recognized by PNC), Applicants holding the dental degree (BDS or equivalent Recognized by PMDC) and post graduation in public health with the reproductive health module covered.

C. MASTERS IN PUBLIC HEALTH (NON-COMMUNICABLE DISEASES) MPH (NCDs) (MORNING PROGRAM)

Enroll in two years (MPHNCDs) program to develop knowledge and skills in fighting against Non-Communicable Diseases. The program provides an innovative learning platform that will help health professionals to become planners, managers, trainers and implementers of non communicable diseases control and preventive programs.

Eligibility Criteria

Sixteen years (16 years) of education in the following fields;

MBBS, MD, BDS or equivalent qualification (Recognized by PMDC), BSc Nursing (Recognized by PNC), BSc Paramedics, BSc Vision sciences, BSc Human Nutrition, BSc Physiotherapy, Pharmacy (Pharm-B, Pharm-D)
